

Scientific Poster Competition Guidelines International Conference on Economics, Social Sciences, and Humanities (ICESH 2025)

Malahayati University

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- 1. The poster competition is open to undergraduate (Bachelor's degree) students of Malahayati University.
- 2. The poster must be based on the student's research project conducted under the supervision of a lecturer (thesis).
- 3. Participants are required to submit the following administrative documents: a scanned Student ID Card (KTM), Curriculum Vitae, Statement of Originality, and Registration Form (available for download at Malahayati.ac.id).
- 4. The digital poster must be in .jpg format, RGB color mode, sized at 595 x 842 pixels (equivalent to A4: 210 mm x 297 mm), vertical orientation, and a maximum file size of 500 KB.
- 5. The digital poster and required documents must be submitted via email to: icesh2025@malahayati.ac.id no later than July 27 at 11:59 PM (WIB).
- 6. Submitted digital posters will be assessed by the internal judging panel of Malahayati University.
- 7. All poster competition participants are REQUIRED to attend the ICESH 2025 event on July 28–29 and display their printed posters on the designated panel boards.
- 8. Finalist participants will present their posters in front of three external judges for 5–7 minutes.

"COMPETITION RULES"

- 1. The decision of the judging panel is final, binding, and cannot be contested.
- 2. The scientific poster must be based on original research that has not been previously published in any media, has not been submitted to similar competitions, and/or has never been used for communication purposes.
- 3. If a violation of the above provision (no. 2) is proven, the submission will be disqualified and/or the award revoked.
- 4. All submitted works become the property of the organizing committee and will not be returned.
- 5. The committee reserves the right and authority to publish the scientific posters while crediting the authors.
- 6. The technical and visual style is open, but the work must be original and must not include elements that infringe on copyright or violate ethical standards (not copied or plagiarized).
- 7. Posters must be created using commonly used computer applications or software (e.g., Corel Draw, Photoshop, or a combination of other applications) and may include graphic photos.
- 8. The design should be visually appealing, with no limit on the number of colors used.

- 9. Poster format:
 - a. Title of the Scientific Poster
 - a. Concise and clear title
 - b. Author's name and faculty of origin
 - b. Background Describes the research problem, significance, and appeal of the work
 - c. Objectives
 - d. Methods
 - e. Research results (text/images/schemes/photos)
 - f. Conclusion and Recommendations
- 10. Posters must meet the following criteria:
 - a. Visible Easy to see
 - b. Interesting Engaging
 - $c.\ Structured-Well-organized$
 - d. Useful Informative and practical
 - e. Accurate Precise and correct
 - f. Legitimate Meets the stated requirements
 - g. Simple Clear and straightforward
